\*In marching band, horn players play mellophone, euphonium and trombone players play marching baritone, tuba players play sousaphone, oboe/bassoon players play flute, clarinet, tenor saxophone, or percussion, percussionists are assigned to the front ensemble or battery(drumline).

In high school, advanced flute players may have the opportunity to play piccolo, saxophone players may have the opportunity to play tenor sax or bari sax, and clarinet players may have the opportunity to play bass clarinet.

Students with a background in piano may have the opportunity to play synthesizer, or piano in jazz band.

The instruments mentioned above are provided for these students. Instrument assignments depend on instrumentation. Assignments normally occur between April and band camp. The examples above are very easy to transition to and from each other.
